Meeting began with welcome address by the co-chairperson.


### Agendas discussed in the meeting:

  - Attendance and IA marks should be updated on-line periodically so as to enable parents to have access to the information regarding their wards
  - Calendar of events, results and repeater list should be provided to concerned departments
  - Early clinical exposure should be conducted at the beginning of 2<sup>nd</sup> term instead of 1<sup>st</sup> term as it is conducted presently
  - To work on developing competency based curriculum
  - It was opined by the board that it is desirable to obtain No objection from students regarding merging of schemes for next academic year.

The following suggestions were made by the members

1. All members suggested that at least 2-3 persons from BOS should be called /invited for the Academic council meeting of the university to have suggestions and to see whether suggestions are implemented or not; without this, next BOS meeting will not have any implications or importance , so as what happened for the suggestions made by BOS members.

2. All members suggested that preparing for **Competitive Based Teaching** from next academic year, teaching skilled labs for all surgical departments under one roof should be developed, that is **Simulation lab and ASK, Audiovisual aids for all lecture halls** is lacking and is affecting UG & PG academics .

3. All members suggested to call one professor/staff to scrutinize the question papers or to suggest changes, as most of the papers are getting exchanged during examination day which is causing inconvenience to the students. At least there should be a subject expert in the exam hall to correct the mistakes immediately. This is to avoid problems during paper corrections and there should be any overlapping of questions.

✓ 4. To introduce OSCE for 25% in clinical subjects in UG examinations

✓ 5. Members also suggested that, as we have 2 internal examiners for PG examinations, one has to be HOD, so that the standard of examinations & PG behavior can be controlled , as many universities are following this norms.

✓ 6. To make 3 theory and 3 clinical tests compulsory and attendance 75% for all UG's & PG's. Those who are not having attendance in each Term, should not be allowed to take further test, so that the attendance will improve. ✓

✓ 7. Fast track examinations for repeaters should be planned as suggested for 2 months ,, that is daily extra class 8:00AM to 9:00AM for one month in 1<sup>st</sup> year & 8:00AM to 9:00AM for other term repeaters.

8. Sitting fee for BOS meeting should be 1000/ for internal and 2000/ for external members.

✓ 9. Suggested by the members that as it is difficult to get examiners for UG & PG, kindly provide flight charges for external examiners both UG & PG, as followed by other universities.

### Agendas discussed in the meeting:


- Implementation of New curriculum proposed by MCI for MBBS course

Coordinator briefed about the new curriculum which will be implemented from the current year.

Since Integration is one of the main components in the new curriculum, it was emphasized to give importance for the involvement and cooperation.

Another important change is the skills demonstration and assessment. Everyone opted for the establishment of skills lab in the institution. This has to be completed by December 2019 as per the MCI guidelines

The timetable for the next year has to be prepared in advance since the number of subjects and integration is too many.

Strong discussions were with respect to the faculty in order to fulfill the criteria of MCI new curriculum. At least 1-2 extra faculties are needed to implement this.

Suggestions were given to the members to start preparing the specific learning objectives at the department level.

Dr. Jagannath, Prof & HOD asked regarding their implementation of the curriculum because of time lag and suggested guidelines for implementation temporal integration for final year students. Dr. Prabhakar, Professor of surgery has supported his suggestions. All members are agreed in this regard and willing to take the training and implement the new curriculum as it is.
2. All members suggested that, the simulations lab to teach better as there is lack of time also.
3. Dr. C V Srinivas, External member told that all colleges are adopting the new curriculum with foundation courses from 1st year MBBS with respect to language problem of students, psycho-social aspects and introduction of mentorship. All members agreed that we had implemented from previous 2 years and it is in progress and also 20% of MCQs based question papers.

Welcome address was give by Dr Manjunath GN, Co-Chairman. All the members of BOS were welcomed including the external member Dr Prathab Profes. or of microbiology, Ramaiah medical college, Bangalore.

Co-chairman briefed about the new CBME curriculum which will be implemented from the current year for 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of MBBS.

Discussion about the new courses to be started from the current year wa. done and few suggestions members were arrived.

1. Certificate course in clinical research
2. Hospital infection control program
3. Forensic odontology
4. Transfusion medicine

Some additional suggestions were also given by the external member regarding the thrust areas like skills course, infectious disease, cytogenetics and pharmacovigilance. These may be taken as a next step ahead.

Decision was taken by the members to introduce Continuous internal assessment dedicating 10 marks exclusively out of 60 marks in IA.

There was a discussion to have mandatory posting to the pharmacology, microbiology, forensic and biochemistry during their internship for 15 days. Later on it was suggested to have mandatory certification of essential skills in skills station as a part of completion of internship as per the CBME curriculum. This needs at least 2 years to initiate, provided planning is started now.





**Minutes of the meeting**

1. **Plan for current Academic session:** Online classes to be continued for students of all terms, revision classes for the exam going term students to be held. After arrival of the students, to follow Govt./University guidelines to conduct examinations.
2. To consider pre examination preparation like revision class, clinical case demonstrations following strict quarantine and physical distancing.
3. All members suggested to conduct online classes for students with clarity of sound and two way interactions with facility to record, so that students can access later for reference, to increase the number of class rooms. External member Dr.Srinivas suggested "Medwiz app" which is good for two way communication and recording of attendance and all members were supported.
4. In case of delay, if need arises clinical examinations can be held with case scenario pattern as suggested by members.
