INTRODUCTION

The University started functioning w.e.f. June 2008 with Sri Siddhartha Medical College and Sri Siddhartha Dental College as constituent colleges. Further as per Govt. of India notification vide No. F.9-31/2006-U.3(A) Dtd.



16/12/2008, the Sri Siddhartha Institute of Technology was included as a constituent college of Sri Siddhartha Academy of Higher Education.

LOCATION

1. Admission Process

As per the directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the Ordinances promulgated by the Central Government. Admission to undergraduate courses in Dental (BDS) for academic year 2021-22 in constituent college of "[Sri Siddhartha Dental College](#)" (SSDC), Tumkur, will be done on the basis of marks obtained in the NEET (UG) 2021. Admission process will be carried out by Medical Council Committee (MCC) / DGHS (Directorate General of Health Services, Govt. of India) Ministry of Health & Family Welfare for academic year 2021-22.

3. Distribution of Seats

a) General Category: 85 % seats are reserved under this category. Admission to this category will be made on the basis of NEET (UG) 2021 Merit list.

b) NRI (Non Resident Indians) / PIO (Persons of Indian Origin) / FN (Foreign Nationals) Category: 15 % seats are reserved under this Category.

The Foreign National (FN), wards of Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) settled abroad and wards of Non Resident Indians (NRI) are eligible to apply under this category.

***100% of seats are filled through NEET (UG) Counseling - 2021 conducted by Medical Council Committee (www.mcc.nic.in), Govt. of India.

4. Eligibility and Qualifications

- Candidate must be an Indian National. The Nationality Certificate issued by the District Magistrate / Additional District Magistrate /Chief Metropolitan Magistrate or a valid passport will be considered as a proof of Nationality.

- He/she has completed age of 17 years at the time of admission or will complete the age on or before 31st December of the year of his/her admission to the 1st year BDS Course.
- The upper age limit for NEET(UG) is 25 years as on the date of examination with relaxation of 5 years for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC category and persons entitled for reservation under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016
- Candidate must have passed any of the qualifying examinations as enumerated below. The Higher/Senior Secondary Examination or the Indian School Certificate Examination which is equivalent to (10+2) Higher/Senior Secondary Examination which is conducted after a period of 12 years study, the last two years of such study comprising of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Bio-technology (which shall include practical tests in these subjects) and Mathematics or any other elective subject with English as a core course.

NOTE: where the course content is not as prescribed for 10 +2 education structure of the National Committee, the candidates will have to undergo a period of one year pre-professional training before admission to the Medical Colleges.

OR

- The Intermediate/Pre-degree Examination in Science of an Indian University/Board or other recognized examining body with Physics, Chemistry, Biology /Bio-technology (which shall include practical test in these subjects) and also English as compulsory subject.

OR

- The Pre-professional/Pre-medical Examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology & English after passing either the Higher Secondary Examination or Pre-University or an equivalent examination. The Pre-professional/Pre-medical examination shall include practical test in these subjects and also English as compulsory subject.

OR

- The first year of the three years degree course of a University recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC) with Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology including practical tests in these subjects, provided the examination is a University Examination and further that

he/she has passed the earlier qualifying examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology and English.

OR

- B.Sc. Examination of an Indian University recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC), provided that he/she has passed B.Sc. Examination with not less than two of the subjects Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany, Zoology)/Bio-technology and further that he/she has passed the earlier qualifying examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English

OR

- Any other examination which in scope and standard is found to be equivalent to the Intermediate Science Examination of an Indian University/Board, taking Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Bio-technology including practical tests in each of these subjects and English. For such qualification, the candidates are required to obtain equivalence certificate from AIU (Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi).
- Candidate belonging to general category must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained minimum 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology taken together at the qualifying examination.
- Candidate belonging to backward classes (SC, ST, & OBC) must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum 40% mark in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Biotechnology taken together at qualifying examination.
- Candidates belonging to the backward class must attach a copy of the caste and caste validity certificate along with the application form. It should however be noted that there is no reservation for students belonging to backward class. This certificate is required in support of relaxation of eligibility criteria i.e. if such a candidate gets admission on the basis of NEET (UG) 2021, but has secured less than 50% marks in qualifying examinations.
- Candidates Qualified (10+2) under a foreign system in India, are required to obtain equivalence certificate from AIU (Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi).

- Candidates belonging to general category who secure minimum of marks at 50 percentile in NEET (UG) 2021 and satisfy the eligibility norms laid down by respective councils will be eligible for admission to BDS Courses .
- Candidates belonging to backward classes (SC/ST & OBC) who secure minimum of marks at 40 percentile in NEET (UG) 2021 and satisfy the eligibility norms laid down by respective councils will be eligible for admission to BDS Courses.

6. Documents required at the time of Admission:

The following mentioned documents are to be submitted in original at the time of reporting to the College as per the schedule announced by MCC for General Candidates:

- 1) Online allotment letter of MCC
- 2) NEET UG 2021 Qualified Marks / Rank Card
- 3) S.S.C. / 10th Standard Statement of Marks
- 4) H.S.C. / 12th Standard / Equivalent Examination Statement of Marks
- 5) Leaving / Transfer Certificate
- 6) Bonafide and Character Certificate from Head of Institution last attended.
- 7) Certificate of Age (S.S.C. or 10th Passing Certificate / Valid passport)

- 8) Caste & Caste validity certificate (by candidates belonging to all Backward class)
- 9) Copy of Aadhar Card
- 10) Migration certificate - Original + 3 copies (other than Karnataka board candidates)
- 11) Physical fitness certificate
- 12) 8 passport size and 8 stamp size photos
- 13) Three self attested photo copies separate sets of above all documents as per above sequence
- 14) Fee Remittance Details OR Demand Draft of Tuition Fees

In addition to the above, the NRI Applicants should have to submit the following additional documents.

- 1) Affidavit of the person who is NRI and the sponsorer.
- 2) Documents claiming that the sponsorer is an NRI (Passport, Visa of the sponsorer)
- 3) Affidavit from the sponsorer that he/ she will sponsor the entire course fee of the candidate.
- 4) Embassy Certificate of the Sponsorer.
- 5) Citizenship of the candidate if holding OCI/PIO
- 6) Relationship with NRI with the candidate as per the court order of Hon'ble Supreme court of India in the case W.P (C) no. 689/2017 - Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Anr. Vs Union of India & Ors dated 22.08.2017
- 7) The degrees/Certificates of the candidates must have been recognized and approved by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) if the qualifying examination is other than the 10 + 2 of India.

The candidates who are claiming to be eligible for admission under NRI quota, has to fulfill the eligibility criteria, as per the directions/orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India

Important Note: NRI Applicants:

- 1) The person sponsoring should hold NRI status and residing abroad and such person should have looked after the student as the guardian. A Notarized Affidavit to that effect should be submitted at the time of admission on a twenty rupee stamp paper.
- 2) NRI quota shall include Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) and Persons of Indian Origin (PIO)
- 3) Course Fee as mentioned in the schedule should be paid in US Dollars. If It is paid in INR, then it should be paid through the NR Account of the sponsorer

7. Cancellation of admission & refund of fees

a) Cancellation: A candidate who has confirmed his / her admission may cancel it by submitting an application to the Competent Authority, along with the following....

- I. Application for cancellation duly signed by the candidate & co - signed by Parent / Guardian.
- II. Original Admission Letter
- III. Original Fees Receipts

b) Cancellation and Refund Policy for Under Graduate course: A candidate who has confirmed his / her admission may cancel it by submitting an application to the Competent Authority of SSDC.

After cancellation of Admission, following rules for refund of fees will be binding on candidate..

- 1) Candidate should inform the institution about his intention to join or not to join the institution.
- 2) It is mandatory to join the institution in stipulated time as mentioned in the counseling schedule to the MCC/DGHS or else his admission stands cancel and vacant seat will be made available to subsequent rounds.
- 3) If candidate cancels the admission before commencement of academic session (as per MCC and DCI guidelines / directions). The Entire amount of Annual Tuition Fees will be refunded after deduction of processing fee of Rs. 10,000/-.

- 4) If candidate does not inform the institution about his intention or does not join within 7 days after start of academic session, his admission stands cancelled. However in such case if institution not able fill up the seat even by end of 30 days after opening academic session, then Annual Fees collected will be refunded after deduction of 50% of the fees collected and processing fee of Rs.10,000/- .
- 5) If candidate cancels the admission after commencement of academic session (as per MCC and DCI guidelines / directions). A candidate has to pay the entire course fee.
- 6) No cancellation is permitted after second round of admission by MCC/DGHS.
- 7) The refund clause mentioned above will also be applicable to the candidates admitted in subsequent round(s).
- 8) The eligible refund will be made within 30 days from date of application for cancellation along with original receipt of fees paid. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained during this period.
- 9) After IInd Round of Admission by DGHS, in event of failure to continue the chosen undergraduate program, for what ever reasons, the students will be liable to pay the complete course fee to secure NOC and return of original documents from the institute concerned. Application needs to be submitted to the Principal/ Dean of the institute to this effect.

c) Cancellation during the conduct of the course

In event of failure to qualify or continue the chosen UG programme, for whatever reasons, the students will be liable to pay the complete course fee to secure NOC and return of original documents from the institute concerned. Application needs to be submitted to the Principal/ Dean of the college to this effect.

8. Commencement of Classes

The B.D.S. course will commence as per the directions of DCI/MCC. (Date will be notified in University / Dental college website) Candidates will be required to be present in the campus and report to the Dean / Principal of the respective college to which he / she is admitted.

9. Discipline

The candidates admitted in the constituent colleges of the University are subjected to the discipline and conduct rule of the SSAHE. A disciplinary Committee will deal with all cases either suo-moto or when referred to by the Dean / Principal of the concerned College. The decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final in this regard.

10. Court Jurisdiction

All legal disputes related to admission procedure to constituent colleges of Sri Siddhartha Academy of Higher Education are subject to the jurisdiction of the Courts at Tumkur and High Court of Bangalore bench at Karnataka, with advance legal notice of one month to SSAHE.

11. Disclaimer

Sri Siddhartha Academy of Higher Education has not authorized any individual as agent or agency to deal with the admission in their constituent colleges. The SSAHE will not be responsible for any activities of such individuals or agencies.

12. Ragging

Ragging within or outside the educational Institutions is strictly prohibited. Ragging is a criminal offence as per dictate of Supreme Court. The University has framed rules and regulations in this regard as per UGC guidelines. Students involved in ragging will be subjected to such disciplinary proceedings including legal action as prescribed.

13. Hostel Rules and Regulations

The Hostel rules called " Hostel Rules & Regulations" are binding on a student pursuing his / her studies in constituent

colleges of SSAHE. The booklet containing hostel rules will be provided to each admitted student at the time of Admission. Students residing in hostel (Boys and Girls Hostel), whenever proceeding to home on emergency or weekend or holiday he/ she should complete the laid down procedure of the hostel.

If the students.....

- 1) Leave the hostel premises without seeking necessary permission from hostel authorities or any intimation or not following laid down procedure of the hostel.
- 2) Do not return or intimate his/ her arrival in hostel in time it will be considered as responsibility of the concerned student and legal parents' guardian.
- 3) In such situation it is mandatory for parents to report of whereabouts of their ward in any circumstances, legal guardian to intimate concerned authorities with necessary documents as proof.

Violation of the disciplinary rules will be followed by disciplinary action as per SSAHE rules.

The university provides comfortable hostel accommodation. Adequate number of international standard hostels for undergraduate and post graduate students of all disciplines (separate for boys and girls) with multi-gym, Wi-fi, indoor sports and advanced communication facilities are provided in the campus.
