GNANA SAMANVAYA **COLLABORATION AGREEMENT**

This Collaboration Agreement ("Agreement") is executed and entered on this the 6th day of November, 2015, ("Effective Date") at Bengaluru **BY AND BETWEEN**

Principal Secretary to Government, Education Department (Higher Education), Government of Karnataka, having its office at 6th Floor, M.S. Building, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Veedhi, Bengaluru – 560 001 (hereinafter referred to as "GOK") on the First Part;

Private and Deemed Universities in Karnataka listed in **Annexure 1** to this Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "**Partner Universities**" or "**PU's**") and represented by their respective Chancellor / Vice-Chancellor / Registrar on the Second Part.

And

Universities and other Higher Education Institutes of the Government of Karnataka listed in **Annexure 2** to this Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "**Coordinating Universities**" or "**CU's**") and represented by their respective Chancellor / Vice-Chancellor / Registrar on the Third Part;

WHEREAS the Government of Karnataka is keen on introducing reforms to improve the quality of higher education in Government Colleges and other educational and academic institutions of higher education, that are presently a constituent of or affiliated to one or more CUs (hereinafter referred to as "Government Educational Institution" or "GEI"), and to build greater linkages between educational institutions and the society they serve, more particularly those located in the rural and semi-urban areas of the State.

AND WHEREAS GOK has held discussions with the Coordinating Universities (CUs) and various Private and Deemed Universities (the Partner Universities), in Karnataka, to adopt and partner with one or more Government Educational Institution with a view to develop a strong, collaborative relationship between them and the partner private/deemed University.

AND WHEREAS the PUs are willing, based on the representations made by GOK, to adopt and partner with one or more GEI presently affiliated with one or more CUs to enhance the quality of the GEIs' academic and research activities through a collaborative relationship including the developing and offering of programs in higher education so that its students are equipped with



both theoretical knowledge and practical skills and experience, an integrated approach to academics, research, training, real life problem solving and entrepreneurship.

AND WHEREAS the GOK and the CUs, through this Collaboration Agreement, have agreed to co-ordinate the activities contemplated under this Agreement with the Partner Universities such that the GEI(s) can take advantage of the knowledge and skills that PUs are willing to offer to the GEI(s) to further the intended objectives of this Agreement.

1) Definitions:

- a) "GOK" means the Education Department, Higher Education, Government of Karnataka;
- b) "Coordinating University" shall mean the Government University or Universities to which the particular Government Educational Institution is presently affiliated with or is a constituent of;
- c) "GEI" shall mean one or more of the Government Educational Institutions located within the State of Karnataka
- d) "Confidential Information" means any information in any form that is disclosed to Recipient by or on behalf of Discloser that is not generally known including, without limitation, trade secrets, knowhow, samples, techniques, work flows, protocols, specifications, drawings, designs, design concepts, processes and testing methodologies including any information specifically marked "Confidential" or "Proprietary" at the time of disclosure.
- e) "Discloser" means the Party disclosing the Confidential Information.
- f) "Intellectual Property" includes any idea, process, trademark, service mark, ABC invention, technology, computer hardware and software, original work of authorship, design, formula, discovery, patent, copyright, product, work flows, protocols and all improvements, knowhow, rights and claims related to the foregoing.
- g) "Recipient" means the Party receiving the Confidential Information.
- h) "Party": GOK, Coordinating University, Partner University or GEI are individually referred to herein as a 'Party' and collectively as the 'Parties'.
- i) "Partner University" shall mean the private or deemed university and its associate institutes in the state of Karnataka which is participating in this agreement

2) Scope of the Agreement:

- 2.1 The overall purpose of the collaboration is to contribute to the improvement of quality of the GEIs. The areas of collaboration between the PUs and the participating GEI(s) may include one or more of the following areas of education, training or research programs.
 - a) Providing mentorship to students and Faculty members on academic and research topics;



- b) General and Industry-relevant Skill development programmes;
- c) Soft Skills training programmes;
- d) Local Community development programmes, awareness programmes, health and welfare camps and programmes etc.;
- e) Establishing resource centres including language training centres, communication centres, knowledge hubs, libraries or other infrastructural facilities that will benefit students, faculty members and local communities at large;
- f) Providing linkages with industries, corporate entities and other agencies for enhancing the quality of education and research activities;
- g) Career counselling;
- h) Facilitating student and teacher exchange programmes, training and development programmes in best practices in academics, research, training and other activities etc.,
- i) Encourage participation by students and teachers in various conferences, seminars, symposia, workshops conducted by the PU;
- j) Provide support and/or jointly conduct Seminars, Training workshops, Conferences, Publications and other such activities with the GEI(s);
- k) Generally extend academic, technical and administrative support to students, faculty members, research scholars and other members of participating GEI(s) for such activities that enhance capabilities and skills by providing access to PU's infrastructural facilities, e-content and other teaching and other infrastructural resources wherever possible to supplement the above activities.
- l) International Centre in the University, best practices on recruitment and methods to be shared with State Universities for mutual benefit or vice versa

2.2 The collaborations detailed in **Clause 2.1** above shall be governed by the detailed Terms and Conditions described within this Agreement.

2.3 GOK, in consultation with the CUs and PUs, will finalize the names of the Districts and the participating GEIs from each District that will partner with each of the PUs to undertake the activities under this Agreement. The initial list of Districts allotted to the PUs is attached as Annexure 3 to this Agreement. GOK along with the CUs and PUs may, by mutual discussion and agreement revise the names of the Districts allotted and/or the participating GEIs and inform the concerned PUs, in writing, as appropriate from time to time.

2.4 The CUs, GEIs and PUs shall, by mutual agreement, discuss and agree upon the specific areas, activities or programmes where the cooperation and/or collaboration will occur and the manner in which each of these will be undertaken. CUs hereby agree to make every effort to coordinate the smooth and orderly implementation of these programmes with the GEIs and PUs concerned.



3) Terms and conditions for this Agreement.

a) Voluntary nature of collaboration:

The Parties hereto agree that the services provided by PUs under this Agreement are purely on a voluntary basis and no legal obligations on PUs arise under this Agreement.

b) Documentation for Activities undertaken:

The collaborating CIs, GEIs and PUs concerned shall prepare and sign off on appropriate documents to evidence the specific terms and conditions, they have mutually agreed upon, for each activity or programme they undertake, in terms of this Agreement, before commencing such activity.

c) Relationship between the Parties:

Nothing in this Agreement is intended to or shall operate to create a partnership or joint venture of any kind between the Parties or between PUs and GEI(s) or to authorize any Party to act as agent for the other, and no Party shall have authority to act in the name or on behalf of or otherwise to bind the other in any way.

d) Intellectual Property:

Each Party owns, and will continue to own the Intellectual Property that it owned prior to this Agreement, or that it created or acquired independently of its obligations pursuant to this Agreement (collectively, "Retained Rights"). All Retained Rights not expressly transferred or licensed herein are reserved to the respective owner.

Where any Intellectual Property is generated as a result of the collaboration activities undertaken under this Agreement such Intellectual Property shall either be jointly owned by the GEIs and PUs or on such specific terms and conditions of ownership as the GEIs and PUs shall agree upon, in writing, before the commencement of each such activity or programme.

e) Additional Requests:

Any requests exceeding the scope of this Collaborative Agreement will be discussed between the Parties hereto prior to the commencement of work on such requests.

f) Others:

The Terms of working as between the Parties on any other matter not covered in this Agreement shall be agreed by mutual discussions. Any approvals to be obtained by any of the Parties from any other Party shall be obtained in writing and no verbal approvals shall be accepted or binding.



4) Representations by GOK and CUs on behalf of GEI(s):

GOK and CUs agree and hereby make the following representations to the concerned PUs:

a) Confidential Information:

During the course of the implementation of this Agreement PUs may be required to exchange information that may be considered to be confidential and/or proprietary in nature. GOK and/or CUs will cause the participating GEI(s) to execute a Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure Agreement in favour of the concerned PUs whenever required before information of this nature is shared with GEI(s).

b) Use of facilities:

GOK and CUs agree to advise all GEI(s) that their representatives, when on a visit to a PU's premises or other location where any activity is conducted by PU for the benefit of GEI(s), shall be subject to PU's or the Other Party's badge and pass requirements, in effect at the site visited, pertaining to the use of facilities.

c) Liability:

GOK and CUs agree and hereby confirm that the PUs shall not be liable under any circumstances for any personal or property injury or damage done or suffered arising out of or during the course of any visit by GEI(s) Students, employees and/or other members when on the Premises of PU or such other location where any activity contemplated under this Agreement is undertaken. The GEI(s) will be liable for any damage or loss caused by its participants or representatives to any equipment or property of the PU caused due to negligence, mishandling or failure to follow proper instructions.

5) Force Majeure:

None of the Parties hereto shall be held responsible for non-fulfillment of their respective obligations under this Agreement due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such as but not limited to Acts of God, war, flood, earthquakes, strike, lockouts, epidemics, civil commotion, etc., provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such events, the party affected thereby shall give a notice in writing to the other party within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the force majeure conditions continue beyond six months, the parties shall then mutually decide the future course of action.



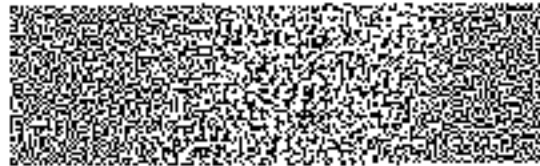



Dear P. Balakrishna Shetty,

Thank you for your response to our invite for the VC's conclave on the 8th November 2019 at Bosch in Bengaluru.

Bosch and Sri Siddhartha Academy of Higher Education can work together in one or more areas of skill development, which are of mutual interest. At this juncture, we are pleased to present to you the following possible areas of collaboration with Bosch as follows:

I. Areas of Collaboration

1.1 Setting up of BRIDGE Centre in the University

Setting up a BRIDGE center in the university campus on cost sharing basis. The center can be used for offering short-term skill based courses to the students of the university or the students from other universities or other learners from the society.

1.2 Organizing Bosch Training of Trainers (ToT) Programs in the University

University Partner to work as a nodal point for Bosch's well-known and successful Train the Trainer program, which Bosch is planning to scale up across different states. There is an opportunity for the university to be a nodal point for this activity for the state or part thereof. The trainers can be offered accommodation in the hostel, classroom and the other facilities on subsidized cost basis. University teachers can be engaged in delivering the training as applicable.

1.3 Capacity Building Workshops for the NGOs

Bosch is planning to organize capacity-building workshops for NGOs on a sustained basis at different locations. University Partner maybe given an opportunity to host such workshops.



1.4 Offering Industry-oriented CSR module to the Master degree students (MSW / MBA / MA or others)

In view of the introduction of CSR Act (Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013), there is a change in the skill sets needed among the social work professionals seeking job opportunities in the CSR departments as compared to earlier aspirations of working with an NGO. Bosch is interested in offering an industry-oriented course, which can be offered as an optional subject. This may improve the employability of the students of the university.

1.5 Offering Internships to Master degree students – locally at BRIDGE Centers

Bosch would like to offer limited no. of unpaid internships in the domain of CSR or skill development to the interested master degree students at the BRIDGE students operating in the state. If approved, Bosch will provide internship certificates to those students who complete their internships successfully.

1.6 Offering Social Entrepreneurship course to Master degree students

Bosch is in the process of designing a social entrepreneurship course for those students who want to pursue self-employment with a motive to serve the society as a major purpose. Would like to explore the possibilities of offering this to the University students.

1.7 Organizing Research Paper Competitions – Doctoral and Master degree students

Bosch would be interested in organizing research paper competitions on the matters related to CSR, skill development and entrepreneurships. University may work as a partner with Bosch to organize such competitions at local or state level.

1.8 Possibility of offering Joint Course for the Trainers – Distance Learning or Blended Learning mode

Bosch is interested in developing a long-term (NSQF Level – 8) course for the development of vocational skill trainers in the country. This course is planned to be delivered in a blended mode – online, face-to-face, assignments, project work etc. University may host few face-to-face training modules and also explore to offer a degree/certificate to the students who complete the course.

1.9 Joint Content Development for New Courses including eLearning

Bosch is interested in developing course contents for new modules, especially for delivery through eLearning mode. University may participate in the process as per the expertise available.

1.10 Offering trainings for MSMEs


2. OBJECTIVES AND SCOPE:

- c. To ensure that the Students in HCG Fellowship courses are awarded a University recognition for their fellowship after a performance evaluation, details of which will be worked out between the respective heads of Departments . (The list of fellowship courses for which affiliation is sought is provided in Appendix 1 , and may be modified after prior intimation and agreement.)
- d. To undertake joint research activities with National and International Funding support (for ex. GOI S&T agencies like DST, CSIR, SERC, etc.)

3. CONFIDENTIALITY:

- a. Both SSAHE and HCG acknowledge that certain Confidential information may be disclosed by one party to the other (the Party that owns and/or discloses the Confidential Information is hereinafter referred to as the "disclosing party" and the Party receiving or accessing such Confidential Information is referred to as "receiving party") during the tenure of this MoU or performance of the respective obligations under the resultant definitive agreements hereunder. 
other confidential or proprietary information the disclosure of which might harm or destroy a competitive advantage of the disclosing party. The mode of communication of information:



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
SSAHE. The two arbitrators shall then appoint a third arbitrator before entering upon the reference. The Arbitration proceedings shall be regulated by the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 and the venue of the arbitration shall be Bangalore, India. The language of Arbitration shall be English. The arbitrators may from time to time with the written consent of Parties enlarge the time for making and publishing the award, which will be binding on the both Parties. The governing law for the purpose of this agreement shall be India. All the courts in Bangalore shall have jurisdiction to try the disputes under this agreement.

6. TERM OF MoU:


This MoU shall be effective from the date of execution hereof and shall remain in force for a period of 3 years or until terminated by either party as above or replaced by a definitive Strategic Alliance Agreement between the Parties whichever occurs first. The Parties may mutually agree to extend the period of this MoU.

Provided that the projects already accepted for implementation will be completed by each Party performing the activities and discharging the obligations assigned to it pursuant to the relevant definitive agreement and the Parties agree that all such activities and transactions will be governed by the relevant definitive agreement, notwithstanding the termination of the MoU. On the termination/expiry of this MoU each Party will return all property belonging to the other Party and hereby undertakes not to use the said proprietary or Confidential information / trade secrets of the other Party in any manner whatsoever without seeking the prior written consent of the other Party.
- b. Either Party shall also be entitled to terminate this MoU for cause in the event of:
 - i. Breach by the other Party of the terms and conditions of this MoU and its failure to remedy such breach within a period of 30 days from date of receipt of a written notice in this regard from the non-breaching party.

The filing by or against the other Party in any court of competent jurisdiction of a petition in bankruptcy or insolvency, or for a scheme of rearrangement (reorganization) with creditors, for the appointment of a receiver or trustees; or the making of an assignment for the benefit of creditors, and such petition is not discharged within 60 days of its filing.

8. AMENDMENT



F-9-31/2006 U.3(A) Dtd. 30/05/2008, Accredited by NAAC with 'A' grade. Most of the departments of the institute are accredited by NBA.**



- c. The purpose of this MoU is with reference to exploring the areas of cooperation, benefiting both the Institute and **North Dakota State University** for the benefit of students in the collaborating institute.

Both parties undertake to (i) hold all such Confidential Information in strictest confidence, (ii) not to disclose such Confidential Information either in whole or in part to any person other than those of its officers, employees and agents who need to know the Confidential Information for the purpose authorized hereunder provided that each such officer, employee or agent has agreed in writing to maintain the confidentiality of the Confidential Information in accordance with the terms hereof or (iii) not to use such Confidential Information for any purpose whatsoever save as may be strictly necessary for the performance of this MoU. This clause pertaining to confidentiality shall survive the term of this MoU and remain in full force and effect not withstanding any termination of this MoU.



5. **Intellectual Property Rights:** IPR titles or ownership of any products, proprietary information or technology tools, processes, utilities, and methodology including any North Dakota State University proprietary products or components thereof used hereunder or development of any deliverables and all new ideas, inventions, innovations, or developments conceived, developed, contributed, distributed or made by North Dakota State University hereunder, and all customizations, enhancements and modifications thereof, need not be transferred from North Dakota State University to the Collaborating Institute on account of use of the same as part of any work under this MoU and shall always remain with both North Dakota State University and the collaborating institute.
6. In no event shall either party be liable for any indirect, incidental, special, consequential damages, including, but not limited to, loss of profits, revenue, data or use, incurred by the other party in connection with, arising out of or under this MoU save for any such loss suffered resulting from any willful and grossly negligent act or omission of either of the parties.
7. Neither this MoU, nor any activities described herein, shall be construed as creating a partnership, joint venture, agency or other such relationship. Both parties agree that this MoU represents a nonexclusive relationship between the parties and nothing contained herein shall preclude either party from participating/initiating similar relationship with third parties.
8. Neither party shall issue any press release, public announcement or other such disclosure concerning this MoU without the other party's prior written consent as to such release or announcement.
9. This MoU may not be amended without the prior written consent of both the parties.
10. This MoU will be effective for five years from 14th November 2019 – 14th November 2024. This MoU can be renewed based on mutual convenience.

If either of the two parties is prevented, restricted, delayed or interfered by reason of:



These Products shall be evaluated for uniqueness and shall be jointly filed for patents and shall be marketed and sold by Cadeption Techniserv exclusively and the terms and conditions of the cost and royalty shares shall be done on each product on a case to case basis. The same shall be exclusively recorded in separate MOU's or agreements as and when required.

Through This MOU the Company CADD centre shall extend its services to other departments of SSIT for Development of products in similar lines through EEE SSIT as a channel.

In case he/she opts out due to any reason an appropriate certificate will be issued for only for that course completed by the student. Students will not be eligible for Certification for the courses that they have not completed.

JURISDICTION



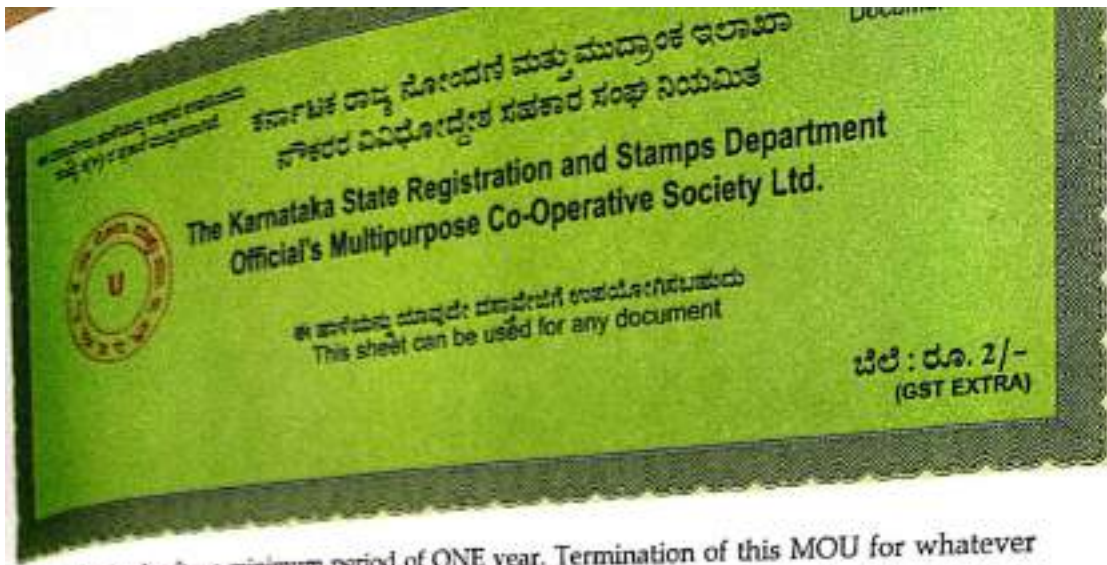
