Clinical Pearl – Interdepartmental Case Discussion

Theme: “When Mastergland Goes Off the Script”

The **Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Sri Siddhartha Medical College, Tumakuru**, conducted a **Clinical Pearl – Interdepartmental Case Discussion** on **20 August 2026 from 3:00 PM to 4:00 PM** at the **Nagarjuna Hall**. The academic session was organized with the objective of promoting a **multidisciplinary approach to complex clinical cases** and encouraging interaction and collaborative learning among different specialties.

The clinical case was presented by the **Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology** under the theme “**When Mastergland Goes Off the Script**.” The case discussion highlighted the importance of systematic clinical evaluation, appropriate investigations, differential diagnosis, and multidisciplinary decision-making in the management of patients whose clinical presentation involves multiple organ systems.

The session witnessed active participation from the Departments of **Medicine, Neurosurgery, Endocrinology, Radiology, Pathology, Ophthalmology, and Neurology**, along with the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology. Each specialty contributed its perspective to the case, enabling a comprehensive discussion of the clinical presentation, diagnostic approach, interpretation of investigations, and principles of management.

Particular emphasis was placed on **clinicopathological and radiological correlation**, the role of endocrine assessment, neurological and ophthalmological evaluation, and the importance of coordinated care in complex cases. The interactive nature of the session encouraged participants

to discuss differential diagnoses, investigation strategies, and appropriate management approaches from their respective specialties.

The program provided an excellent platform for **interdepartmental academic interaction** and helped postgraduate students and faculty appreciate the value of integrating knowledge across specialties rather than approaching complex clinical problems from a single-department perspective.

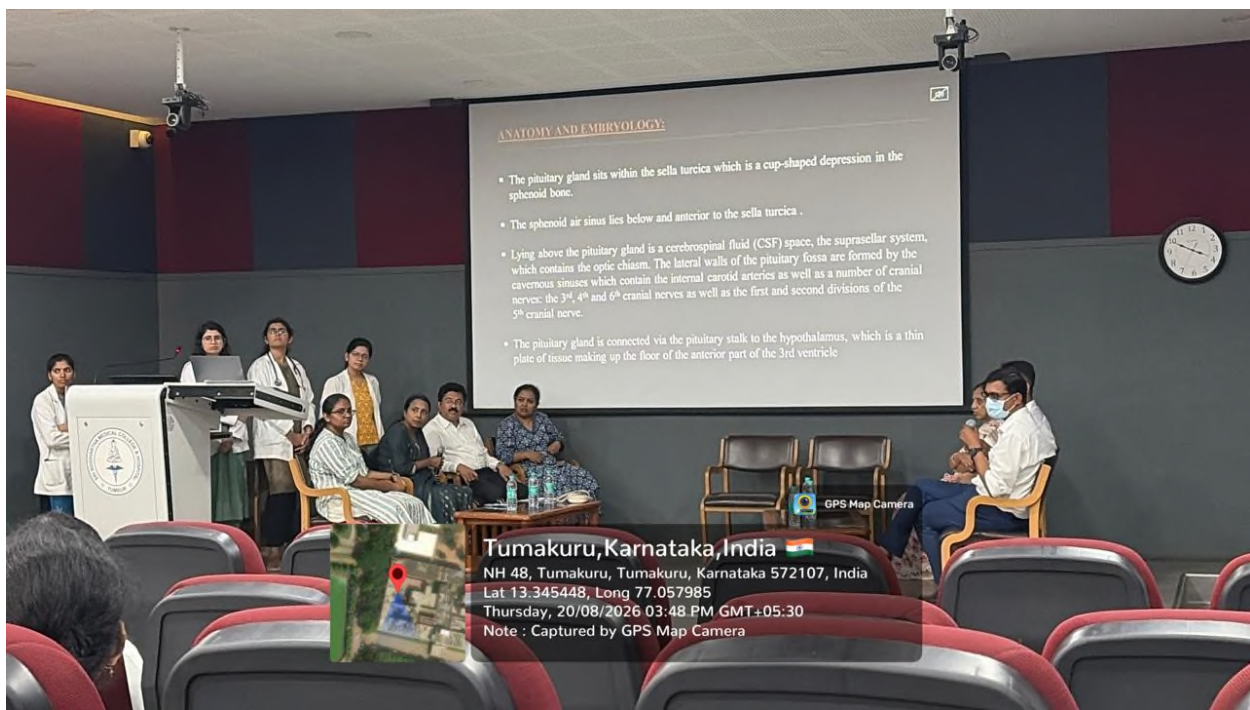
