Minutes of meeting

- Dr. Nandini T addressed the Meeting.
- All the staff members were present during the meeting.
- The meeting commenced with a welcome note to all staffs.

Medical:-

- The schedule for the III Internal Assessment Examination was reviewed:
 - Theory: 07/08/2026 & 08/08/2026
 - Practical: 10/08/2026 to 13/08/2026.
- Dates for the preparation of Internal Assessment theory question papers were finalized, and responsibilities were discussed among the faculty members.
- The attendance status of MBBS students was reviewed.
- A departmental decision was taken regarding students with attendance below 60% and those with attendance above 60%. The decisions will be communicated to the respective MBBS students.
- The department discussed and planned the organization of an MBBS Continuing Medical Education (CME) programme on AETCOM during the month of June, to be coordinated by the faculty members of the Department of Pharmacology.

PGs:-

- The importance of adhering to the allotted schedules for seminars, Clinical Pharmacology classes, and Experimental Pharmacology classes was emphasized.



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- Faculty members agreed that postponement or rescheduling of scheduled academic activities should be avoided except under unavoidable circumstances.

Dental (BDS):-

Nursing:-

- The ongoing Nursing classes were reviewed.

Allied Health Sciences (AHS – BSc & Diploma):-

- The progress of BSc and Diploma classes was reviewed.
- Permission for 2–3 classes, considering students' cultural activities, was discussed.
- The appointment of staff for the MSc Clinical Research Programme was noted.
- It was discussed that teaching responsibilities would be shared, and Pharmacology faculty would handle only selected topics.

Updates presented by:

- Clinical Pharmacology (Pharmacovigilance, Materiovigilance, DTC, Prescription Audit)

a) Clinical Pharmacology Committee

- The committee reviewed its ongoing academic and clinical activities.
- Faculty members discussed strengthening rational prescribing practices and integrating clinical pharmacology activities with undergraduate and postgraduate teaching.
- The committee was found to be functioning actively.

b) Pharmacovigilance Programme (PvPI)

- The department continued to function as an active Adverse Drug Reaction (ADR) Monitoring Centre.
- **Adverse Drug Reactions (ADRs)** received from various clinical departments were collected, assessed, documented, and reported to the appropriate authorities as per **Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (PvPI)** guidelines.
- The committee reviewed the ADR reporting status and encouraged continued sensitization of healthcare professionals regarding spontaneous ADR reporting.
- The following pharmacovigilance awareness activities conducted during the review period were presented:

11/06/2026 – Public Awareness and Pharmacovigilance Sensitization Activity

- **Participants:** Doctors (14), Pharmacist (1), Interns (6), Nurses (5), Patients/Public (74)

c) Materiovigilance Programme

- The Materiovigilance Committee was functioning actively.
- Reports related to medical device adverse events were collected, evaluated, documented, and reported as per the Materiovigilance Programme of India (MvPI) guidelines.
- Faculty members discussed the importance of timely reporting of medical device-related adverse events and continued awareness among healthcare professionals.



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d) Drug and Therapeutics Committee (DTC)

- The activities of the Drug and Therapeutics Committee were reviewed.
- Discussions included promotion of rational drug use, formulary management, and medication safety initiatives within the institution.
- The committee was functioning actively and continued its routine activities.

e) Prescription Audit Committee

- Prescription audit activities conducted during the review period were discussed.
- The committee continued periodic prescription audits to evaluate prescribing practices and promote rational prescribing.
- Suggestions for improving prescription quality and compliance with institutional guidelines were reviewed.

f) Institutional Ethics Committee (IEC)

- The activities of the Institutional Ethics Committee were reviewed.
- Ongoing research proposals, protocol reviews, and ethical approvals were discussed.
- The committee continued to function actively in accordance with ethical and regulatory guidelines.

g) Institutional Animal Ethics Committee (IAEC)

- The functioning of the Institutional Animal Ethics Committee was reviewed.
- Research protocols involving laboratory animals and compliance with applicable regulatory guidelines were discussed.
- The committee was functioning actively and monitoring animal research activities as per institutional and national regulations.

h) Medication Safety Activities

- The successful conduct of the Seminar on "Drug Recall and Rapid Alert System" for nursing personnel was reviewed.

- AETCOM classes are successfully completed.



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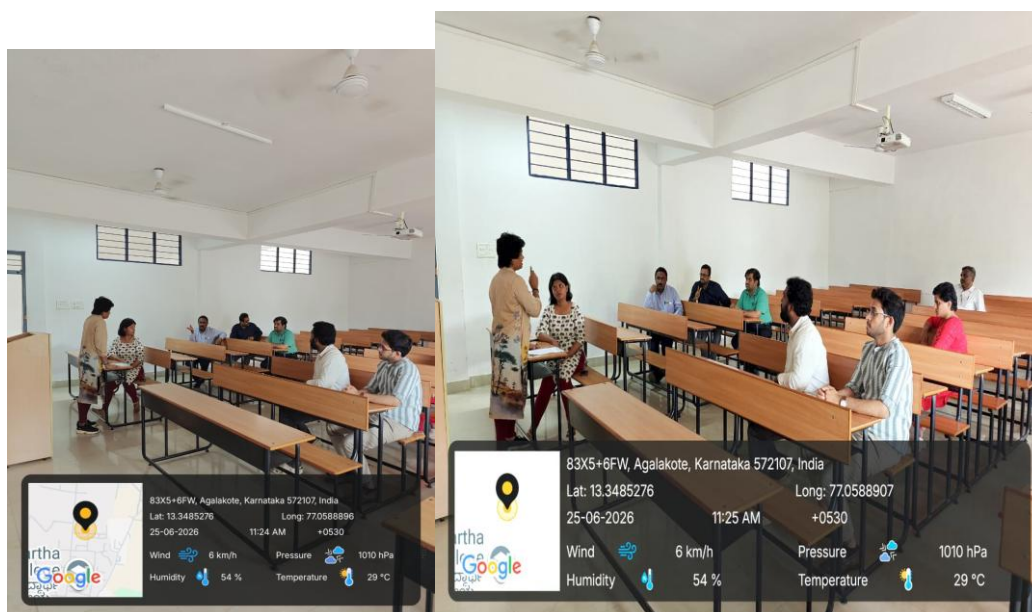
- Sensitization programmes are being conducted regularly, with 1–2 programmes organized every month.
