The Foundation Course for Phase I MBBS students of the academic year 2025–26 will commence on October 06, 2025, and will continue for a period of two weeks in accordance with the guidelines of the National Medical Commission (NMC). This program marks the beginning of the MBBS journey and is designed to orient students to the medical profession, help them adapt to the institutional environment, and introduce them to the essential skills required for their academic and professional growth. Attendance in the Foundation Course is compulsory for all students.

Students are required to report to the campus on or before October 05, 2025, so that hostel allotment and admission-related formalities may be completed in time. During the Foundation Course, students are expected to strictly adhere to the prescribed dress code. Women are required to wear saree, salwar kameez, or churidar with loose-fitting trousers, while men must wear a formal full-sleeved shirt and trousers. Formal footwear is mandatory. Casual attire such as jeans, leggings, sleeveless garments, or deep-necked tops is not considered appropriate during the program.

As part of the course, students are instructed to bring a yoga mat since yoga and wellness sessions will form an integral component of the schedule. To facilitate a smooth academic beginning, each student will be provided with a welcome kit containing stationery, aprons, scrubs, textbooks, and a stethoscope during the orientation program.

The Foundation Course will conclude with a Valedictory ceremony, after which the regular MBBS classes will formally commence. Parents and guardians are requested to kindly ensure that their wards comply with the above instructions so that the program can be conducted in an orderly and meaningful manner.
