Report:

The Department of Pharmacology, Sri Siddhartha Medical College & Hospital, organized a Continuing Medical Education (CME) programme entitled "SADVRITTA: The Implications of AETCOM in Medical Education" with the objective of reinforcing the principles of Attitude, Ethics and Communication (AETCOM) among medical students and faculty. The programme was conceptualized to integrate the timeless ethical principles embodied in *Sadvritta* with the competency-based medical education (CBME) curriculum prescribed by the National Medical Commission (NMC).

The programme provided an innovative platform wherein undergraduate medical students delivered theme-based presentations aligned with specific AETCOM competencies under the mentorship and moderation of experienced faculty members from various medical colleges. Distinguished academicians also delivered expert lectures highlighting contemporary challenges and best practices in ethics and professionalism in medical education.

The programme aimed to:

- Strengthen the understanding of AETCOM competencies among undergraduate medical students and faculty.
- Promote ethical reasoning and professionalism in clinical practice.



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- Enhance communication skills, empathy and patient-centred care.
- Encourage reflective learning through student-led presentations.
- Foster interdisciplinary interaction among medical educators.
- Reinforce competency-based medical education through active learning methodologies.

Programme Proceedings

The programme commenced with registration of delegates followed by a series of thematic student presentations that explored various dimensions of professionalism, ethics and communication in healthcare.

The first scientific session, "Guru-Smarana: The Cadaver as the First Teacher of Dignity and Gratitude", emphasized respect towards human donors and highlighted the ethical foundations of anatomy education. The presentation was delivered by Ms. Bhakti Kori and moderated by Dr. Nandini T., Professor & Head, Department of Pharmacology, Sri Siddhartha Medical College & Hospital.

The second session, "Shraddha-Bandhan: The Sacred Covenant of Trust Between Doctor and Patient," focused on the importance of trust, confidentiality and compassionate doctor-patient relationships. The session was presented by Mr. Dhavin B. M. under the moderation of Dr. Priyadarshini Bai G., Professor & Head, Department of Pharmacology, Siddhaganga Medical College and Research Institute, Tumakuru.

The third presentation, "Dharma-Nyaya: Health Care as a Right, Not a Privilege," deliberated upon equity, justice and accessibility of healthcare services, highlighting the physician's responsibility towards society. The session was delivered by Ms. Kusumitha B. and moderated by Dr. Naveen Kumar, Professor, Department of Pharmacology, Sri Siddhartha Medical College & Hospital.

The fourth session entitled "Samanvaya-Sutra: Professional Teamwork for Safe and Humane Healthcare" highlighted interprofessional collaboration and patient safety. The presentation was delivered by Mr. Pankaj Gharsa under the moderation of Dr. Manjunath G. N.



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The fifth scientific presentation, "Satya-Prakash: Honesty, Healing and Disclosure After Medical Error," emphasized transparency, accountability and ethical disclosure following adverse events. Mr. Ashish C. Narayanan delivered the presentation, moderated by Dr. Narasimha Murthy.

The sixth session, "Samvada-Setu: Communication Across Colleagues and Patients," highlighted effective interpersonal communication and teamwork in clinical practice. The session was presented by Mr. Kushal Banerjee under the moderation of Dr. Arun Hebbar J. N., Assistant Professor, Department of Pharmacology.

Following the inaugural ceremony, the keynote scientific lecture titled "Chikitsa Niti: The Ethical Choices in Modern Medical Education" was delivered by Dr. Sudha M. J., MBBS, MD (Pharmacology), DNB (Pharmacology), PG Diploma in Bioethics, ACME. The lecture provided valuable insights into ethical dilemmas encountered in contemporary medical practice and emphasized the importance of integrating ethical decision-making with competency-based education.

The post-lunch scientific session resumed with "Antim-Yatra: Ethics, Empathy and Grace in the Final Journey," addressing compassionate end-of-life care and dignity in death. The presentation by Ms. Hema C. was moderated by Dr. Lohit K., Professor & Head, Department of Pharmacology, Sri Siddhartha Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre.

Another important session, "Nishtha-Rekha: Integrity and Boundaries in Doctor-Industry Relationships," focused on conflict of interest, ethical prescribing and professional integrity. The presentation by Mr. Monish Gowda B. C. was moderated by Dr. Swamy, Professor, Department of Pharmacology.

The final student presentation, "Kutumba-Sparsha: Understanding the Silent Burden of a Sick Patient's Family," sensitized participants towards family-centred care and empathetic communication. The session was delivered by Mr. Varun under the moderation of Dr. Mohammed Ziauddin Sarkhil, Professor, Department of Pharmacology, Sridevi Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Hospital, Tumakuru.

To reinforce the concepts discussed throughout the day, an interactive quiz competition titled "Ethos Quest" was conducted, enabling participants to assess their understanding of ethical



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principles, communication skills and professionalism in an engaging manner. The programme concluded with the valedictory function and distribution of certificates.
