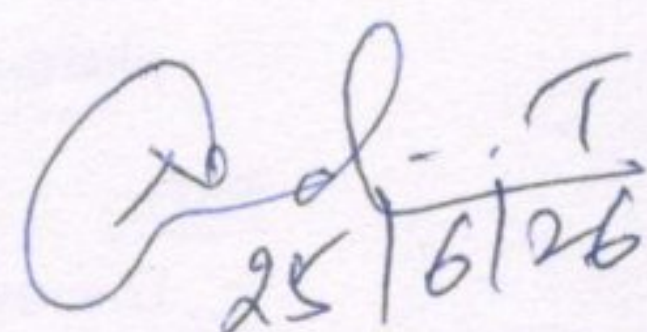
- Report on the College Council Committee Meeting attended by Dr. Swamy R M.
