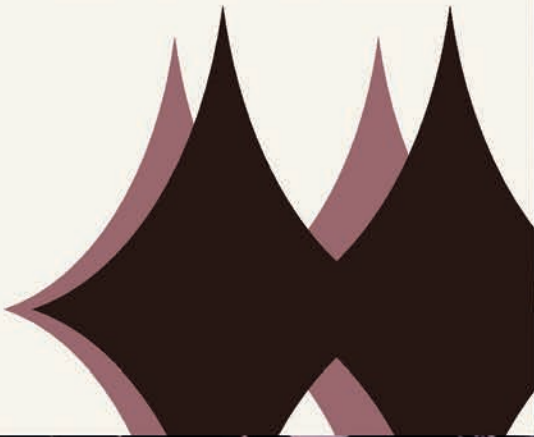

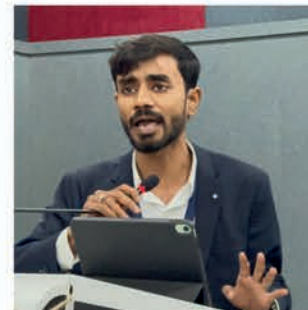

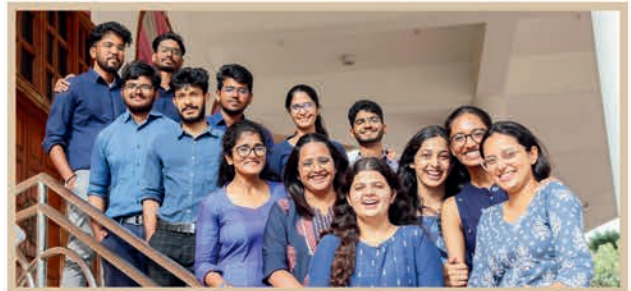

The week-long extravaganza transformed our campus into a kaleidoscope of colors, sounds, and emotions, showcasing the rich diversity of our student community.

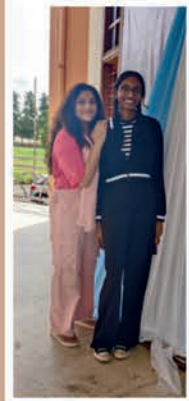
